This form is issued under authority of Section 211.59, M.C.L. as amended. Filing of this form is voluntary.

**INSTRUCTIONS:** This application must be filed before February 15, or by the due date of your winter taxes if due after February 14, with the Treasurer of your city, village or township. **Do not send this application to the Michigan Department of Treasury.**

**NOTE:** Although filing of this form is voluntary, your tax due date will not be extended unless this form is filed.

- Totally and Permanently Disabled
